4. Interested Bidders shall submit the electronic Bids through www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp to the on or before 12:00 pm NST on 2077/11/12.
5. Bids shall be opened in presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend on 12:25 pm NST, 2077/11/12 at the office of Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days counting from the day of bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security, amounting to a minimum of [insert amount NRs. 2,65,000.00 which shall be valid for minimum 30 days beyond the bid validity period.
6. If the last date of submission and opening falls on a government holiday then the next working day shall be considered the last day. In such a case the bid validity and bid security validity shall be recognized with effect from the original bid submission deadline.
