**Preliminary Precipitation and Temperature Summary
June 2026.**

Highlights

June 2026 brought below-normal rainfall to Nepal. The country received 207.14 mm of rain on average, compared to the normal of 274.69 mm (1991-2020). This equals 75.4% of the normal rainfall. Maximum temperatures and Minimum temperatures remained above normal.

Synoptic Sequence

The monsoon reached eastern Nepal on 19 June 2026. It covered parts of Koshi Province at first. By 22 June, it had spread to all of Koshi, Madhesh, and Bagmati Provinces. It also reached parts of Gandaki Province and a few places in eastern Lumbini Province. By 30 June, the monsoon covered the entire country.

No low-pressure systems formed over the Indian subcontinent during June. This lack of strong monsoon disturbances contributed to the lower rainfall. Four Western Disturbances (WDs) affected Nepal instead. These were active during 3-7 June, 10-14 June, 15-18 June, and 18-30 June.

Until 19 June, Nepal felt the influence of WDs and local winds. After 19 June, the weather resulted from a combined effect of the monsoon, WDs, and local systems.

Precipitation

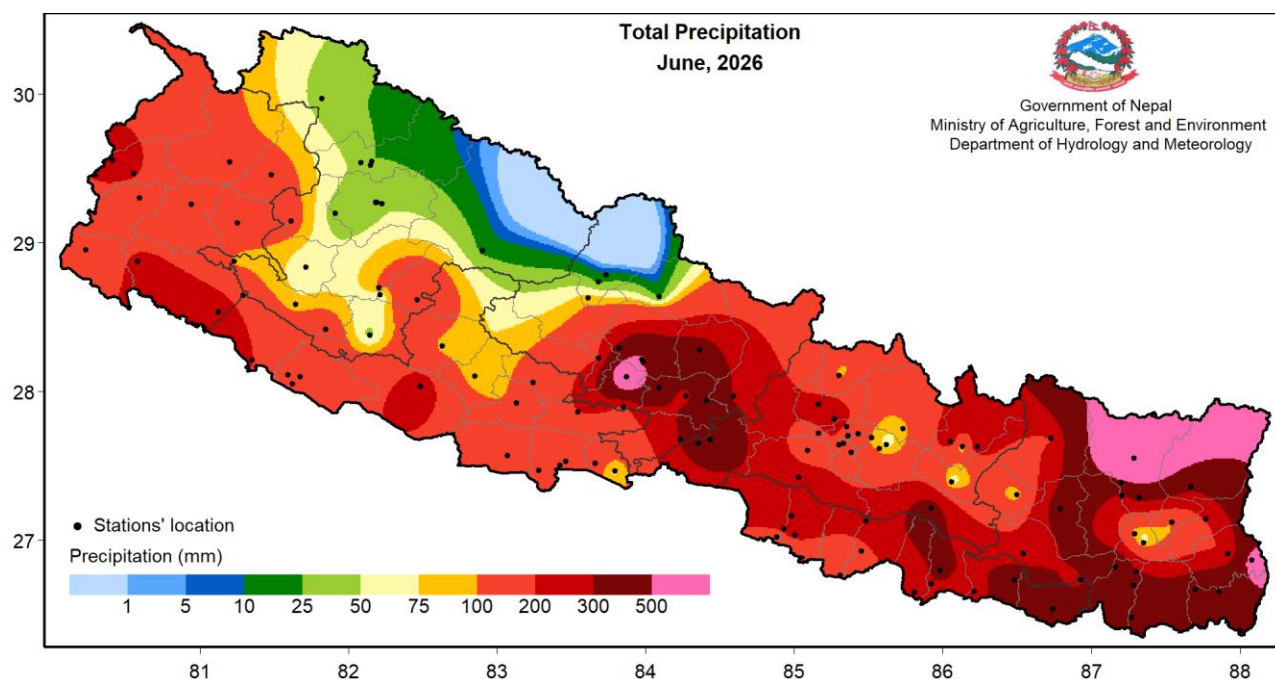


Figure 1 Total precipitation in June 2026

Karnali Province and the western parts of Gandaki Province received less than 100 mm of rain. A few areas in Koshi and Gandaki Provinces received more than 500 mm. Most parts of Koshi Province recorded over 200 mm (Figure 1).

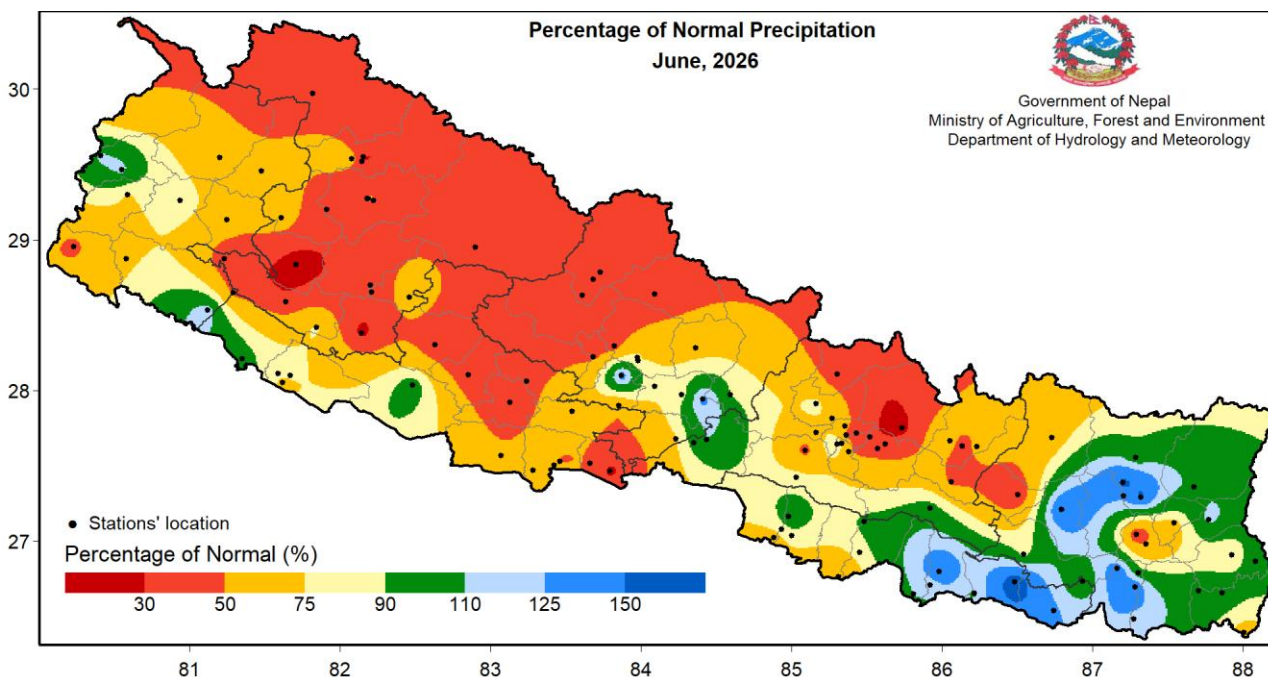


Figure 2: Percentage of normal precipitation in June 2026

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Most of the country received below-normal rainfall. However, the eastern parts of Madhesh Province and most of Koshi Province recorded normal to above-normal rainfall. The eastern parts of Madhesh, most of Bagmati, the eastern half of Gandaki, most of Lumbini, and Sudurpashchim recorded between 50% and 90% of normal rainfall. Few parts of Lumbini and Bagmati, the western half of Gandaki, and almost all of Karnali recorded less than 50% of normal (Figure 2).

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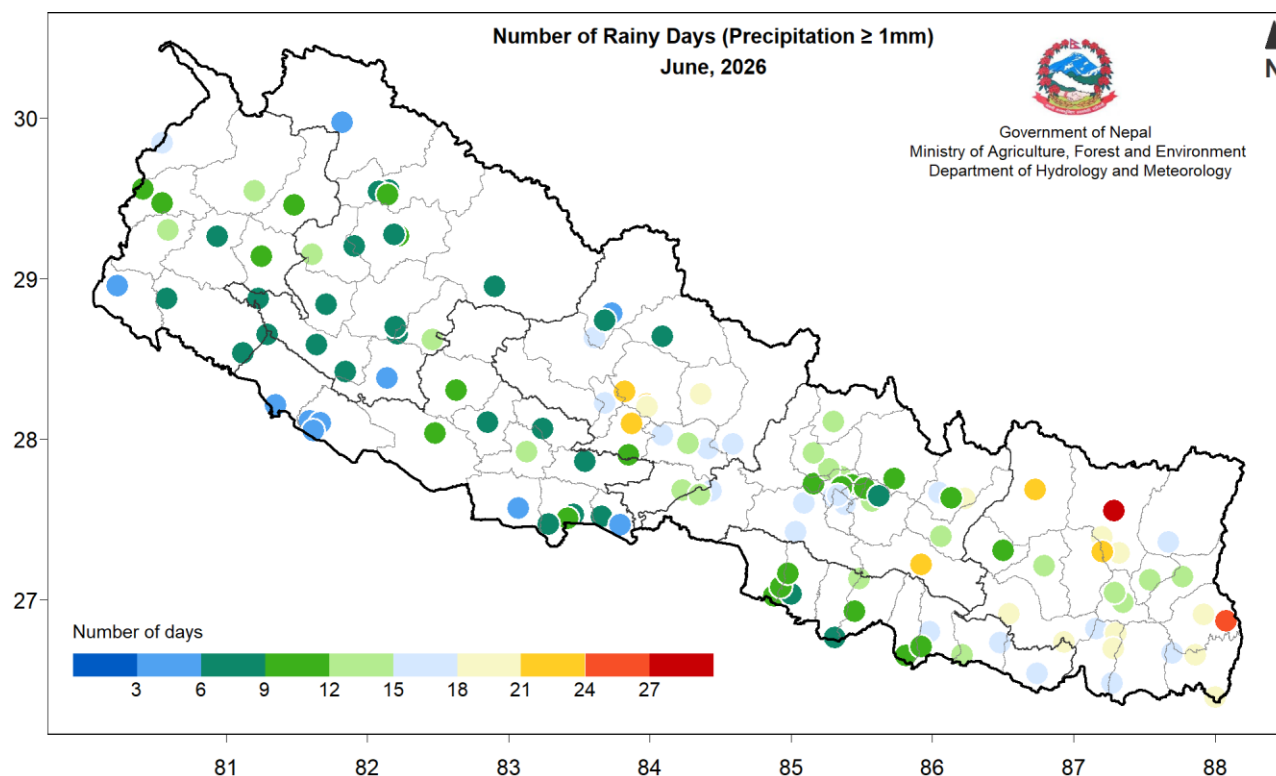


Figure 3: Number of Rainy days ($\geq 1\text{mm}$) during June 2026

Most stations of Koshi Province, Bagmati Province and Gandaki province recorded precipitation in most number of days during June. Num station in Sankhuwasabha District recorded measurable rain on 28 days. Kanyam Tea Estate in Ilam District recorded rain on 26 days. Lumle station in Kaski District recorded rain on 24 days. Fifteen stations recorded rain on more than 20 days. Jomsom station in Mustang District recorded rain on only 4 days (Figure 3).

Tamghas station in Gulmi District recorded the highest single-day rainfall of 81.6 mm on 27 June. Num station in Sankhuwasabha District recorded the highest monthly total of 283.7 mm. Charikot station in Dolakha District recorded the lowest monthly total of 13.9 mm. Seven stations recorded more than 200 mm: Num, Pokhara Airport, Kechana, Chatara, Damauli, Charikot, and Lumle. Thirty-one stations recorded between 100 mm and 200 mm. The remaining 86 stations with measurable rainfall recorded less than 100 mm (Annex 1). Based on data from 124 stations, Nepal received 75.4% of its normal June rainfall. Rajbiraj station in Saptari District recorded the highest percentage of normal rainfall at 1262%.

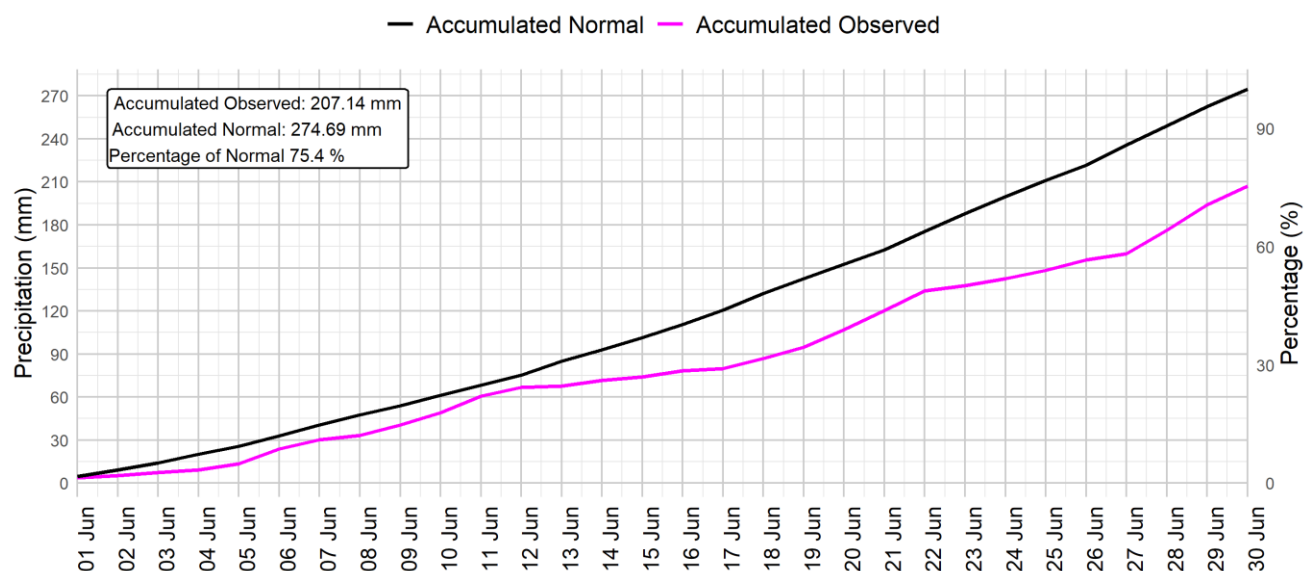


Figure 4: Cumulative average of daily normal and observed precipitation during June 2026



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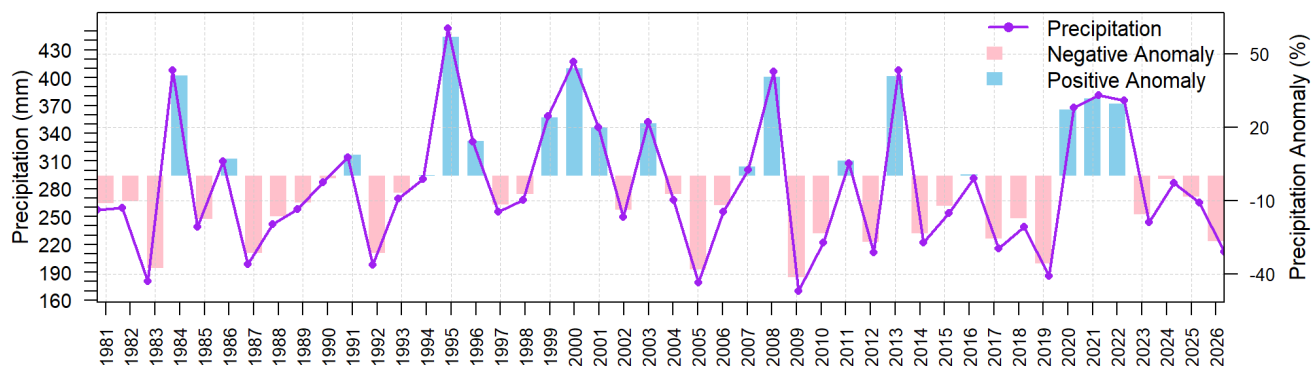


Figure 5: All Nepal monthly total precipitation of June from 1981 to 2026 (average of 104 stations)

The cumulative daily rainfall remained below normal throughout the entire month (Figure 4). June 2026 recorded a negative rainfall anomaly. This is the fourth consecutive year with a negative rainfall anomaly in June (Figure 5).

Maximum Temperature

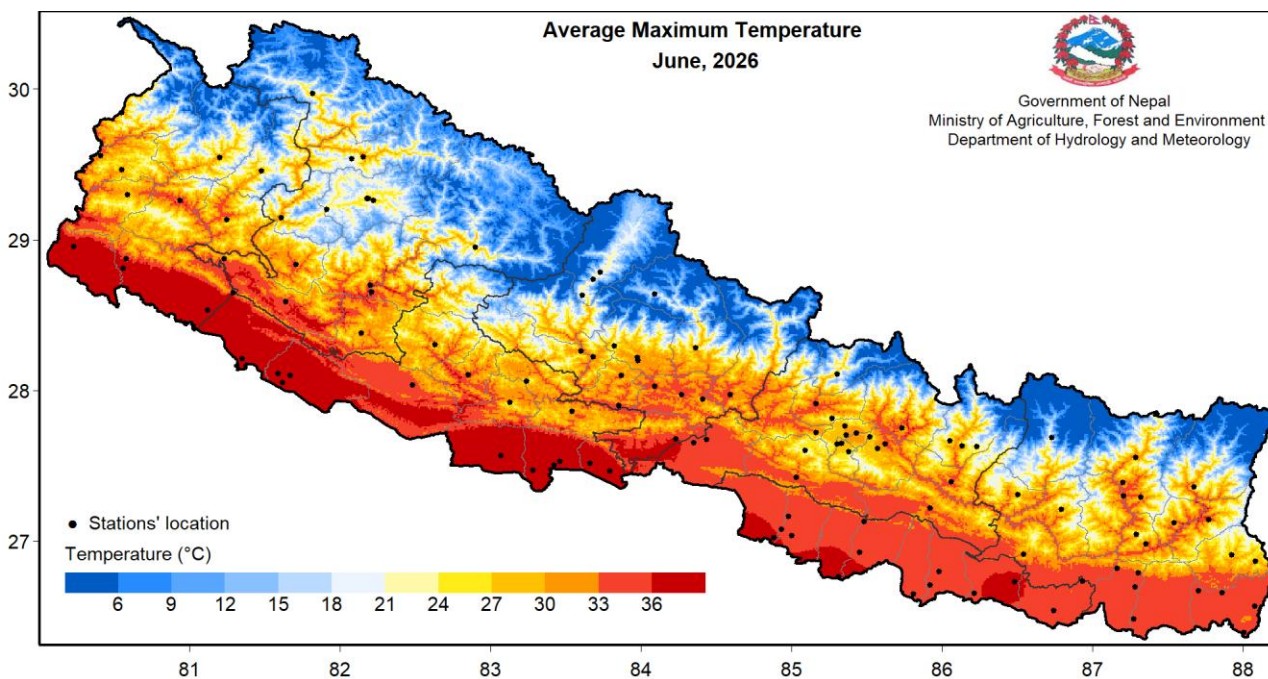


Figure 6: Maximum Temperature in June 2026

Most parts of the Terai areas of Sudurpashchim and Lumbini Provinces, and few parts of Madhesh Province, recorded average maximum temperatures above 36°C. Almost all Terai areas recorded averages above 33°C. The Hilly region recorded averages between 21°C and 36°C. The Himalayan region stayed below 21°C (Figure 6).

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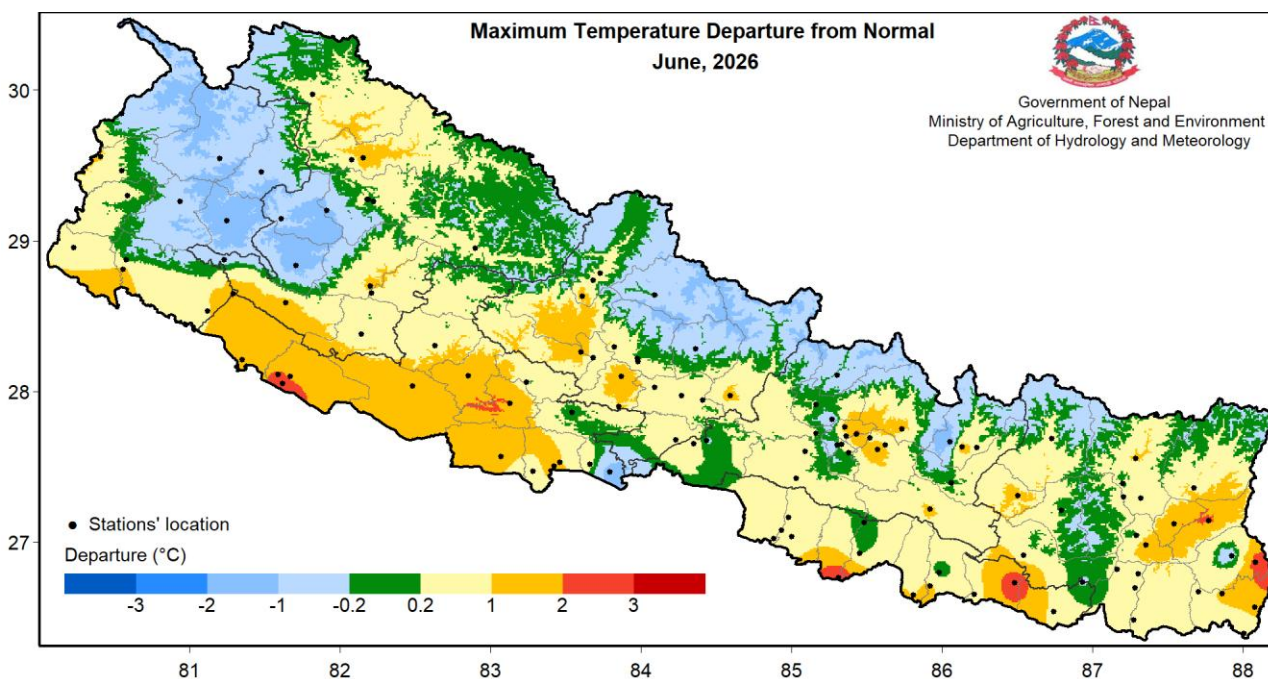


Figure 7: Departure from normal maximum temperature in June 2026

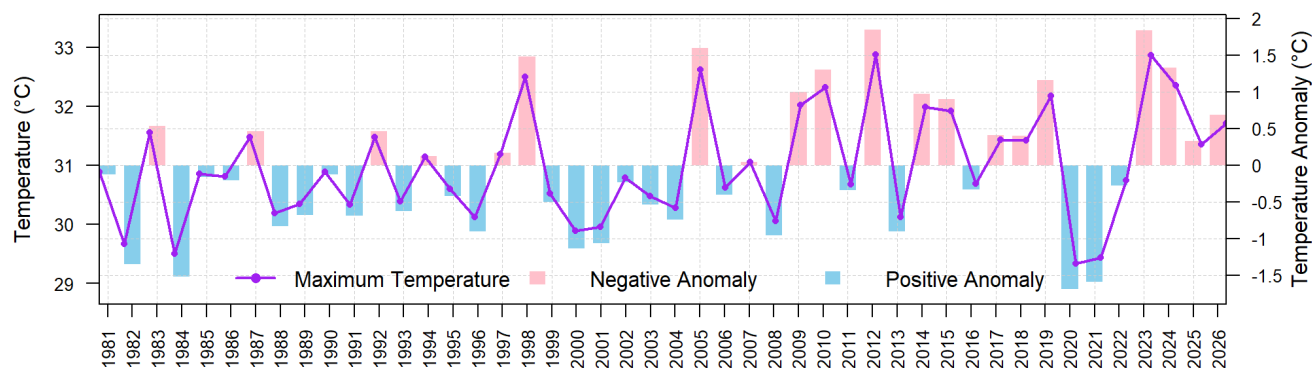


Figure 8: Monthly average maximum temperature anomaly of June from 1981 to 2026 of 66 stations (average of monthly average maximum temperature at stations having long term data)

Most of Koshi, Madhesh, Bagmati, Gandaki, and Karnali Provinces, along with almost all of Lumbini and parts of Sudurpashchim, recorded above-normal maximum temperatures. The rest of the country recorded normal to below-normal maximum temperatures. Temperature departures stayed mostly between -2°C and +2°C (Figure 7). Overall, June 2026 brought below-normal maximum temperatures (Figure 8).

Nepalgunj Regional Office in Banke District recorded the highest monthly average maximum temperature at 38.8°C. Lukla Airport in Solukhumbu District recorded the lowest at 18.4°C. Gaur station in Rautahat District recorded the largest positive anomaly at 3.0°C above normal. Charikot station in Dolakha District recorded the largest negative anomaly at 1.9°C below normal (Annex 1).

The hottest day reached 42.0°C at Nepalgunj Regional Office on 25 June. The coolest day reached 10.8°C at Simikot station in Humla District on 12 June.



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Minimum Temperature

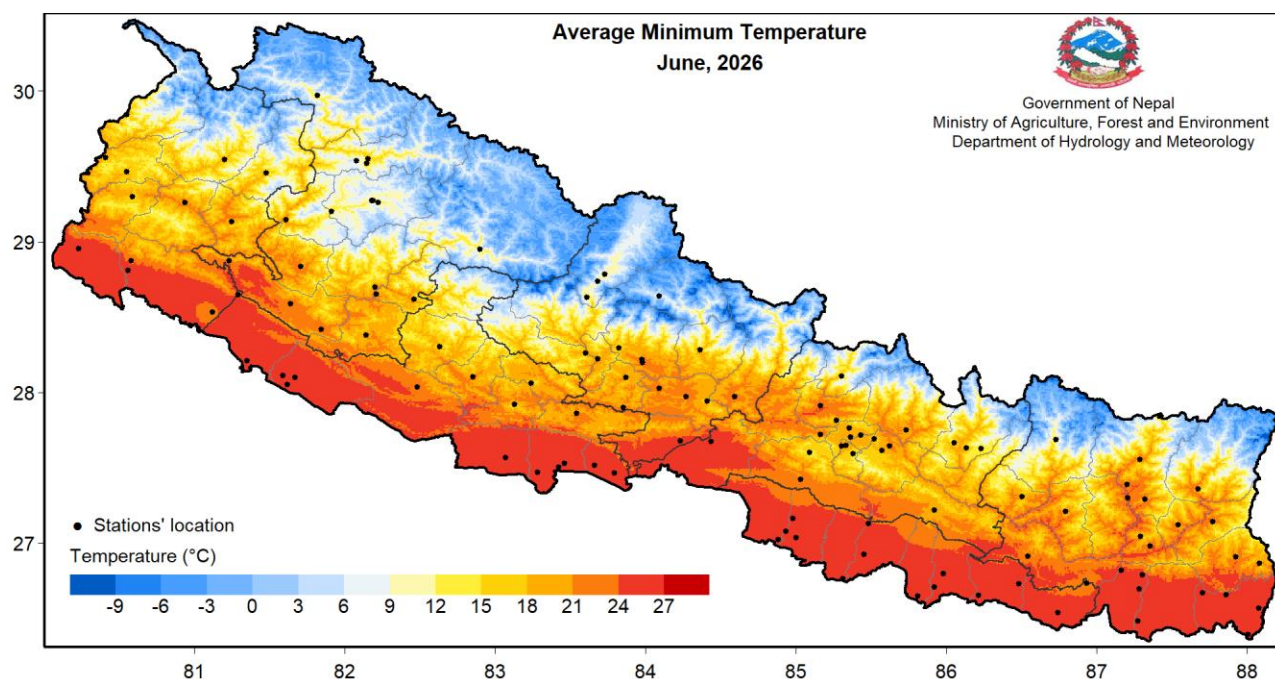


Figure 9: Average Minimum Temperature in June 2026

The monthly average minimum temperature in most parts of Terai remained above 24°C and below 27°C. In Hilly region the temperature lied between 9°C to 21°C. In most parts of Himalayan region, the minimum temperature remained below -9°C (Figure 9).

Gaur station and Humde station of Rautahat district and Manang district recorded the highest and lowest monthly minimum temperature of 26.8°C and 6.5°C respectively. Similarly, the highest monthly anomaly of 11.7°C was recorded at Talcha station of Mugu District and the lowest anomaly of -3.1°C was recorded at Dunai station of Dolpa District (Annex 1). The highest daily minimum temperature of 30.0°C was recorded at Dhangadhi Attariya station of Kailali District on 26th June, while the lowest daily minimum temperature of 0.0°C was recorded at Baitadi Gothalani station of Baitadi district on 3rd June (Annex 1).

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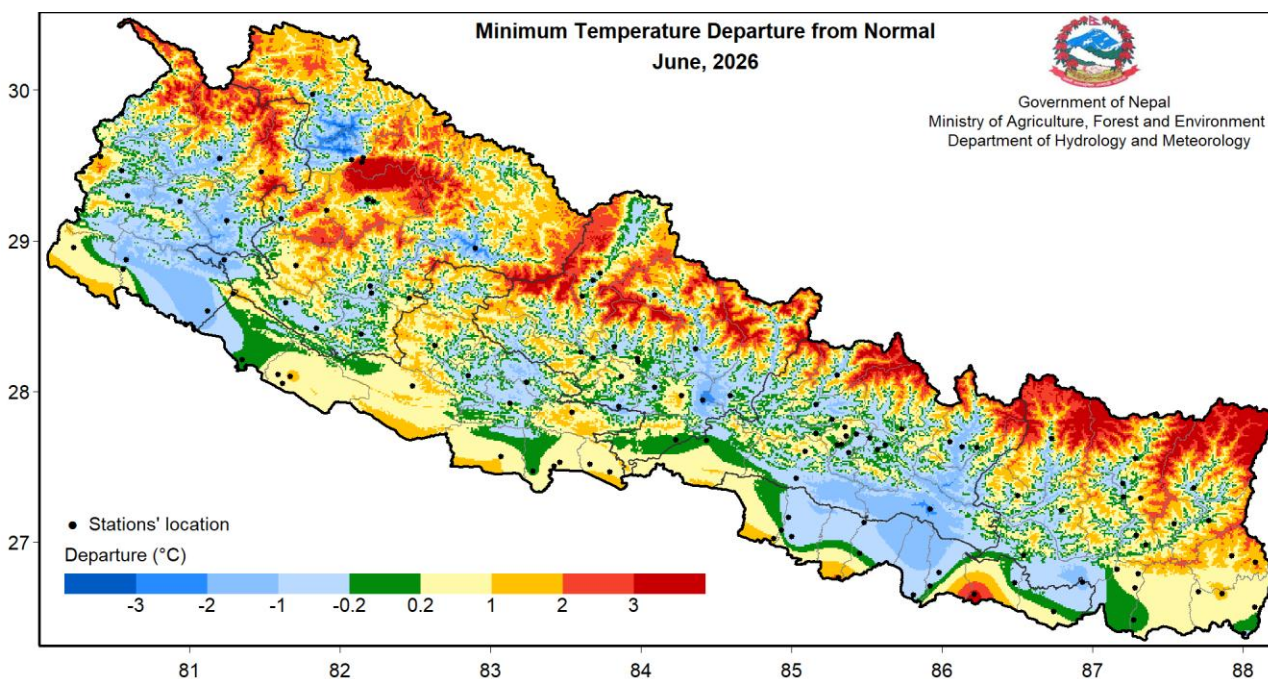


Figure 10: Departure from normal minimum temperature in June 2026

Most Himalayan and Terai areas recorded above-normal minimum temperatures. In contrast, most Hilly areas, and parts of the Terai in Sudurpashchim and Madhesh Provinces, recorded below-normal minimum temperatures (Figure 10).

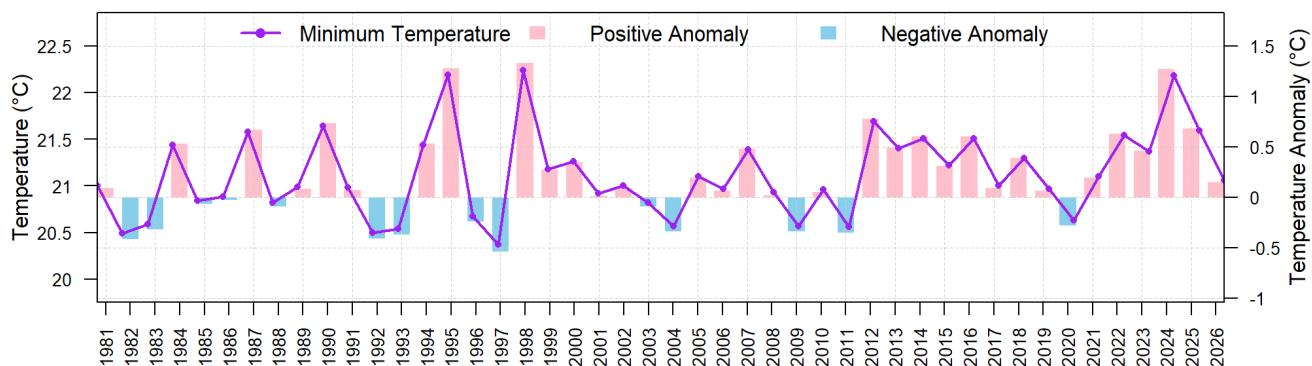


Figure 11: All Nepal monthly average minimum temperature of June from 1981 to 2026 of 64 stations (average of monthly average minimum temperature at stations having long term data)

Overall, a larger area of the country experienced above-normal minimum temperatures than normal or below-normal conditions. The country therefore recorded a positive anomaly in average minimum temperature. This is the sixth positive monthly minimum temperature anomaly since 2021 (Figures 10 and 11).

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Diurnal Temperature Range

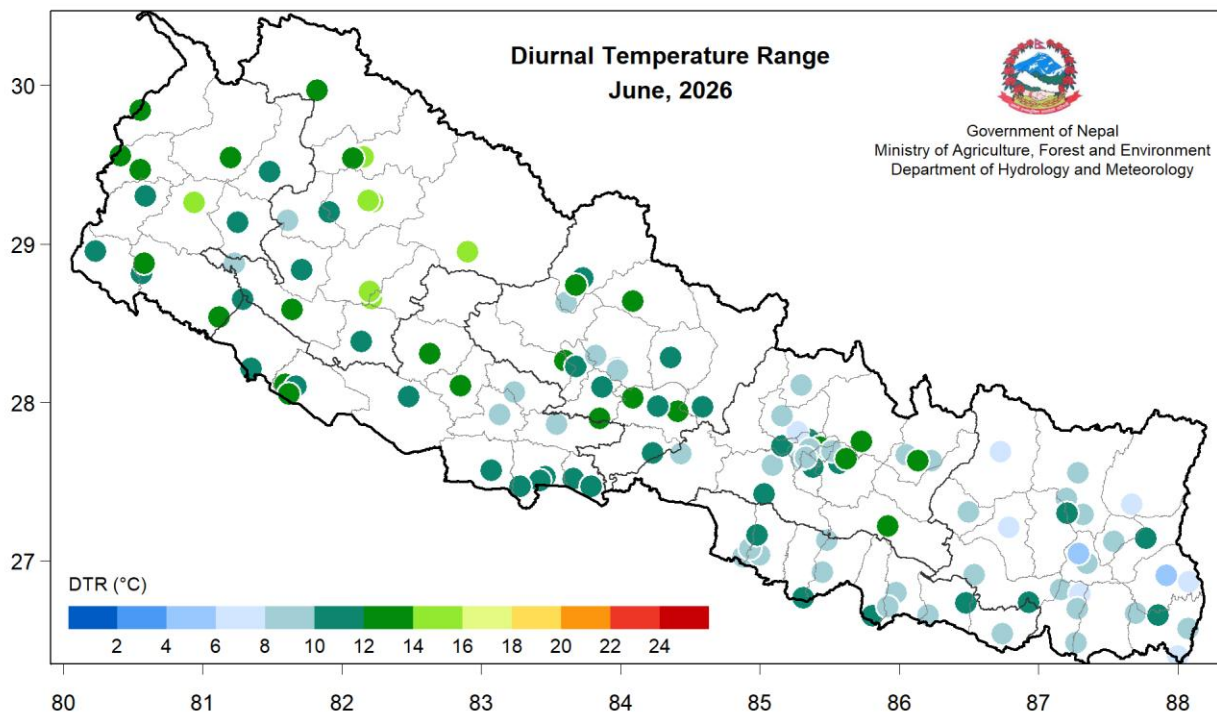


Figure 12: Station plot of diurnal temperature range for June, 2026

Most of the country recorded a diurnal temperature range (DTR) below 16°C. DTR is the difference between daily maximum and minimum temperatures. The three stations with the highest DTR were Dunai in Dolpa District (15.7°C), Jumla station in Jumla District (15.1°C), and Jumla Airport in Jumla District (15.1°C). Ilam Tea Estate recorded the lowest DTR at 4.9°C. The map shows the average daily DTR for each station (Figure 12).
