

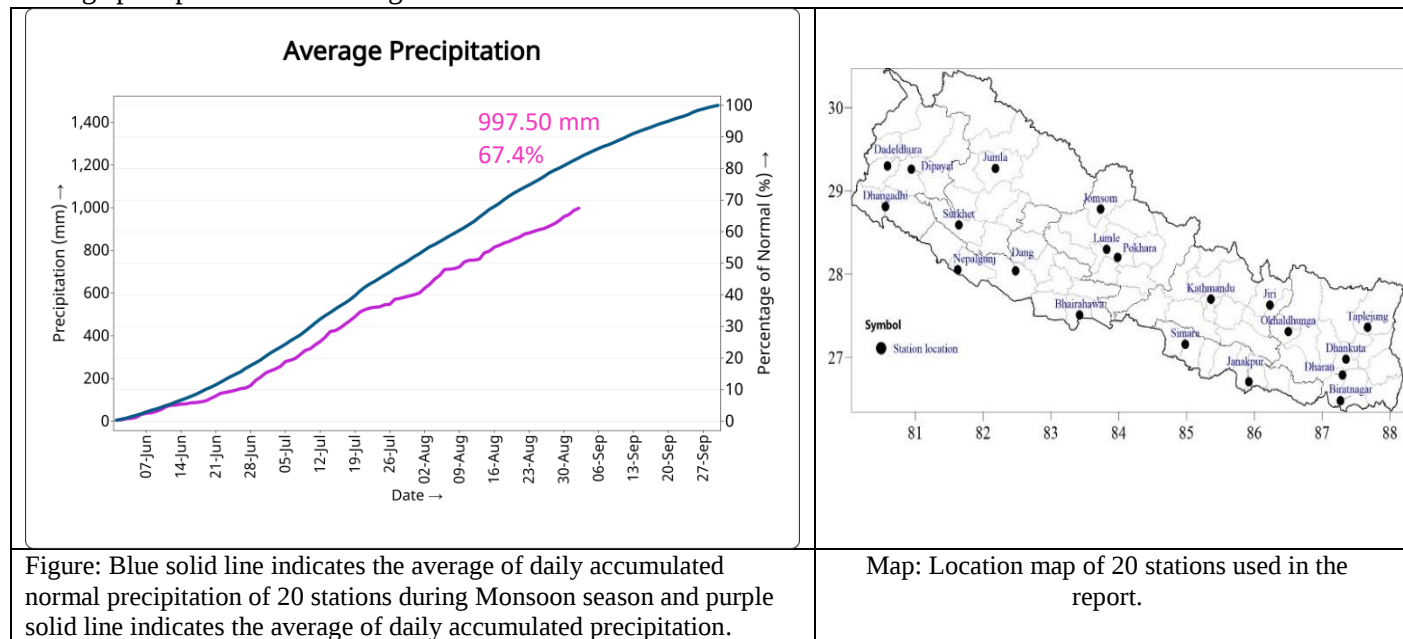

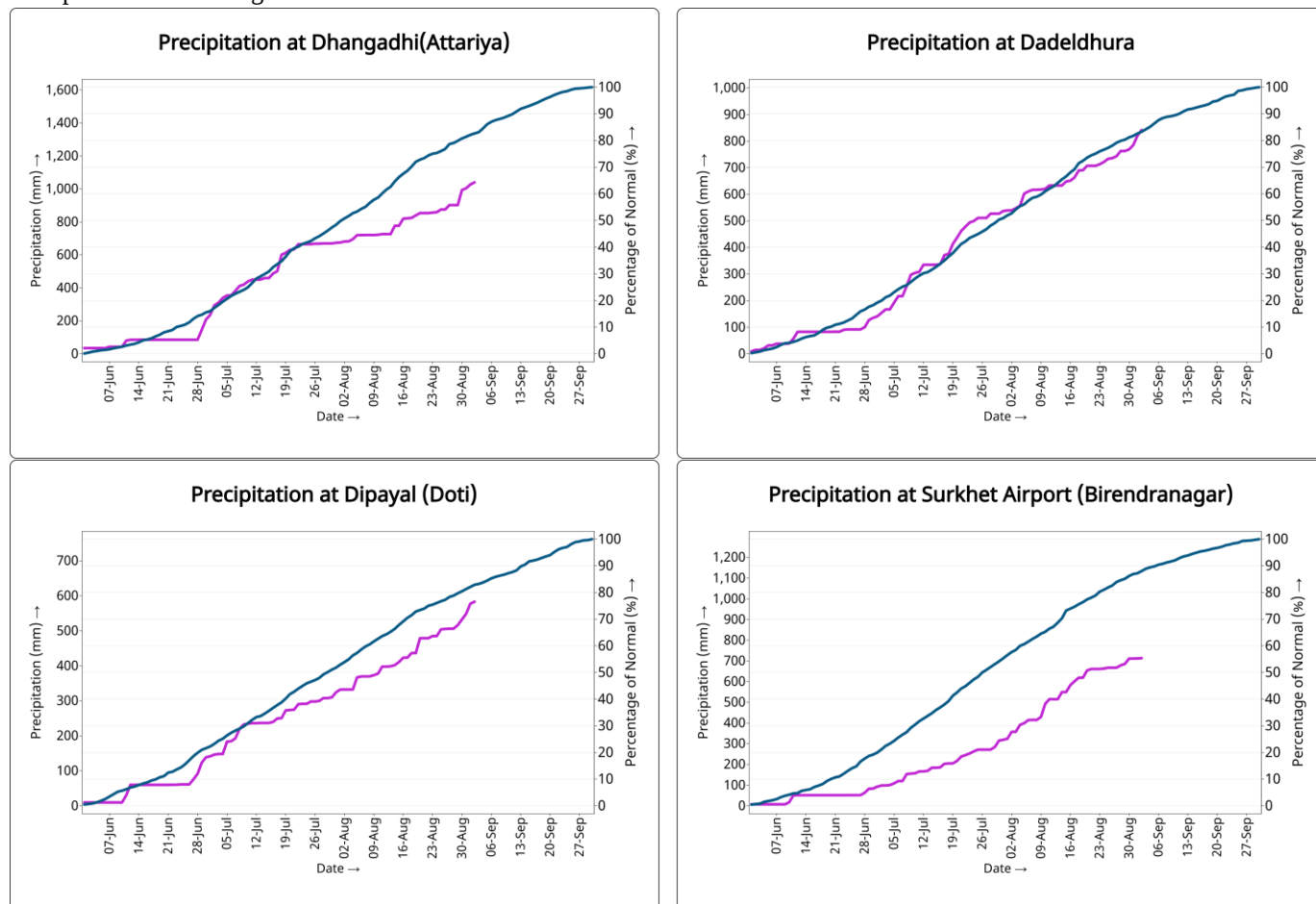

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— Daily accumulated precipitation — Daily accumulated normal *mm → millimeter

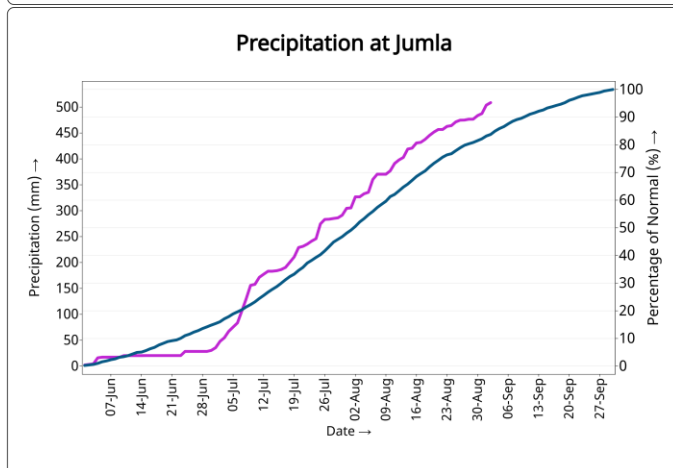
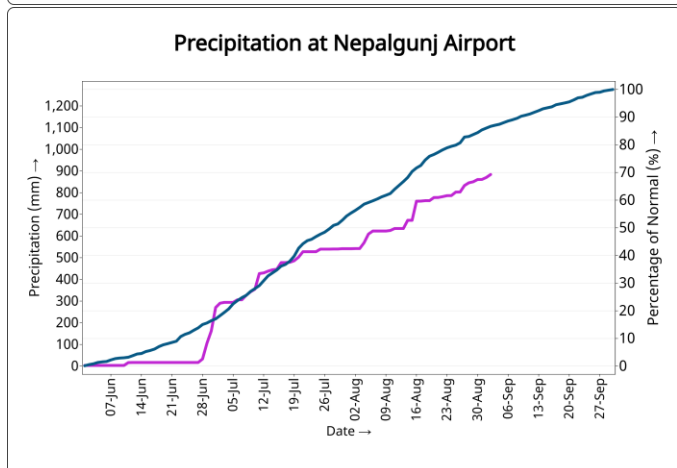
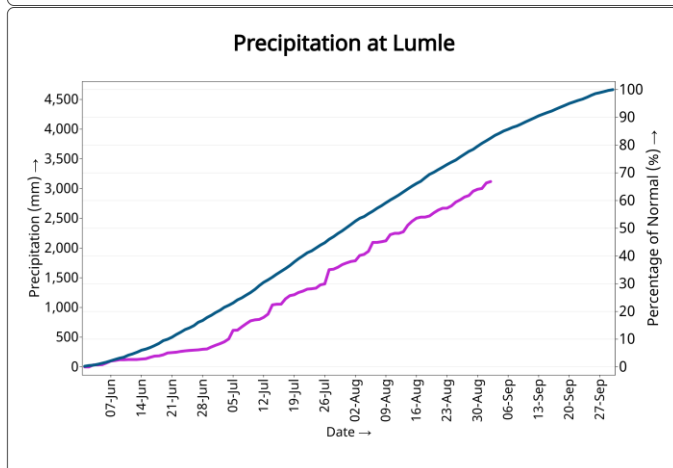
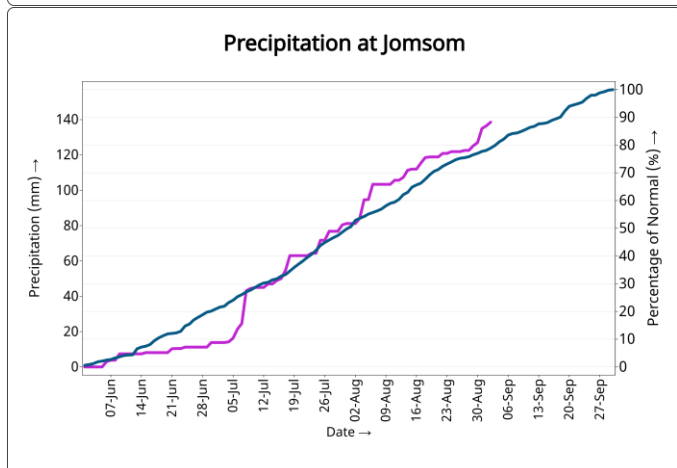
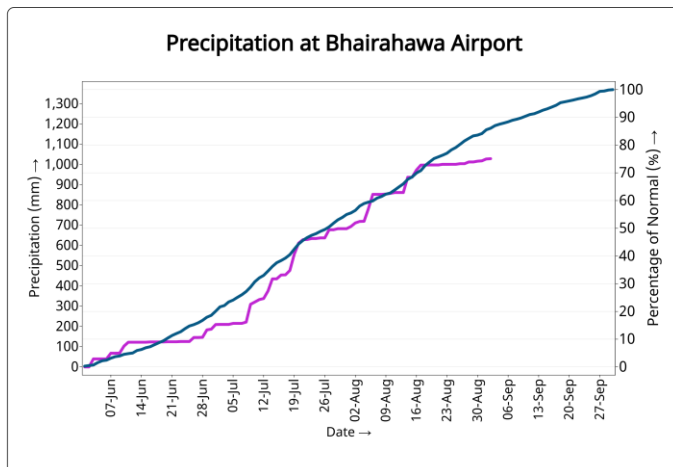
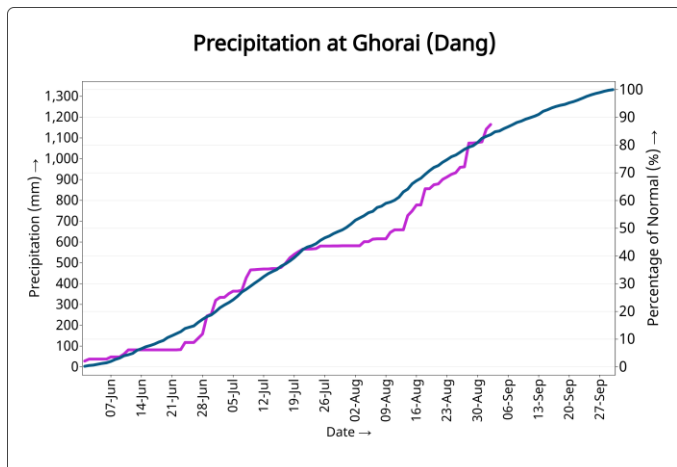
