1. **Department of Hydrology and Meteorology** invites sealed bids or electronic bids from Nepalese eligible bidders for the construction of **Hydrological Stations Maintenance work at Kabhre, Dolakha and Ramechhap** under National Competitive Bidding procedures. The estimated amount for the works is Rs. **24,33,409.00 inclusive of VAT & P.S.**

4. Pre-bid meeting shall not be held.
5. Sealed or electronic bids must be submitted to the **Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu** only through PPMO website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egpon or before **12:00 noon** on **2082/08/29**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at **12.05 pm, 2082/08/29** at the Department of Hydrology and Meteorology, Babarmahal, Kathmandu. Bids must be valid for a period of **90** after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in .pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of **Nrs. 60000.00**, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
